

# 2012 RIM-WRP LANDOWNER PROCESS

*“I’m interested in RIM-WRP, what should I expect?”*



## PRE-APPLICATION

RIM-WRP is a voluntary easement program with specific rules and outcomes, including restoring your site to its natural condition. As you consider applying, make sure you understand both the benefits and changes to your land ownership rights. Land rights change – and you must retire associated programs (like FSA benefits) with the site. If you are unclear with any requirements, please ask. Local and state staff want to work with you to determine if this is a good fit for your long-term goals.



## STEP 1 – APPLICATION

Action	Common Timeframe*
Prepare and submit application with local staff	<b>2 weeks to 2 months</b>
Applications routed to NRCS and BWSR; review and selection	<b>around 6 months</b>



## STEP 2 – OFFER & AGREEMENT

Action	Common Timeframe*
WRP Agreement and RIM draft agreement sent to local office for landowner signatures; agreements signed and returned	<b>around 1 month</b>



## STEP 3 – EASEMENT ACQUISITION & CLOSING

Action	Common Timeframe*
Legal survey and All Appropriate Inquiry; RIM agreement mailed; conservation plan developed; title clearing process; RIM and WRP easement documents approved by State and Federal attorneys; closing occurs; landowner easement payments issued at closing and/or after easement is recorded and final title policy received.	<b>around 2 years</b>



## STEP 4 – LAND RESTORATION

Action	Common Timeframe*
Wetland restoration plan designed and constructed.	<b>up to 5 years</b>
Vegetation plan formulated and implemented.
